 $Let \ all \ mortal \ flesh \ keep \ silence, \ and \ with \ fear \ and \ trembling \ stand;$


Ponder nothing earthly minded, for with blessing in his hand, Christ our God to earth descendeth, our full homage to demand.

Today we commemorate Christ the King. It is a day for expressing our faith that, even though Christ was rejected and crucified, he rose and ascended, and forever reigns with the Father and the Holy Spirit in glory. Jesus' reign means that no mighty power, no tragic suffering, no evil force will have the last word; the last word is Jesus. It also means we may look to Jesus's life – his humility, his sacrifice, his compassion for outcasts – for a model of true kingship.
